

**Bertrand Farm**  
**Community Sponsored Agriculture(CSA)**  
**at Good Shepherd Montessori School**  
**Working Membership Agreement 2018**

The following list details the responsibility of each CSA working membership.

1. Each full working membership will contribute \$375 to be used for the purchase of needed seed, soil amendments, fertilizers, equipment maintenance, tool replacement, hired help and any other materials for the 2018 growing season. A shared membership, half memberships, is \$200. and requires a separate contract from each half member.
2. Each working membership is required to work a pre-set day, Wednesday or Saturday, 7:30am- 10:30am. April work is optional and on Saturdays only. Weekly work commitment begins May 1 and ends September 16, 2018. Monday and Wednesday workers are welcome to work Saturdays in May. (April and May starting times will vary as daylight lengthens). Beginning June 1, all members will work on their appointed day only.
3. After October 1, working members are invited back to u-pick for themselves from whatever we may still have growing in the fields until heavy frosts.
4. If a member must miss a day, every effort should be made to get a substitute, a current half member should be the first choice or a sub from the substitute list (list will be provided). If 3 days are missed by a working member with no substitute, the membership is forfeited.
5. Our success depends on all members giving a strong 3 hours of work. Working children may accompany adults, but if children are too young to be helpful, it takes away from your commitment to the community. Each working membership must provide at least one working adult for the entire 3 hours. If young children are present a second adult is expected to be available for children's needs and safety. Children must be with an adult at all times while at the urban farm.
6. Member agrees to jointly, with BF, assume any loss of produce due to weather or uncontrollable circumstances, not to exceed initial investment of membership contribution.
7. BF will grow all produce under the guidelines required for organic production imposed by OMRI , the Organic Materials Review Institute.
8. Each membership will receive a produce box (1 bushel), to be used for produce transport. It is the member's responsibility to bring their box weekly.

9. Produce will include, but not be limited to, those fruits and vegetable listed (multiple varieties of each)
